

RULE IMPACT STATEMENT 2021

TITLE 38:10-7

Subchapter 7 is amended to strike subjective language in 10-7-2 (a) and (b) regarding “good moral character.” Also, in 10-7-8, grammatical errors are corrected and in 10-7-9 reciprocity rules are amended to expedite reciprocity for members, retirees and spouses of the military.

The persons most likely affected are candidates seeking application for our credentials and these changes will make application a little easier.

Consumers will benefit due to less restrictive or subjective language.

The Board will benefit with clearer language in the rules.

Candidates will benefit by finding language which is easily understood.

Employing agencies will have a better understanding of requirements for applicants.

Implementation of these changes will have no financial impact or minimal financial impact to candidates applying for credentials. There is no economic impact on any political subdivision or require cooperation in implementing or enforcing rules.

The proposed rule changes will not have any adverse economic effect on small businesses.

There is no less costly or non-regulatory method or less intrusive method for achieving the purposes of these rule changes.
